- Minimum 18 years of age
- Valid Ontario drivers licence

## Apprenticeship Program

2400 hours of on-the-job training, supplemented by two 8-week sessions of in-class technical training.

- Setting up & removing access equipment
- Working on concrete, masonry, steel, wood and pre-cast erecting projects
- Handling materials and equipment and perform demolition, excavation and compaction activities
- Site security
- May specialize in operating off-road vehicles, drilling and blasting, scaling, sandblasting, high pressure washing, diving, tunnelling and performing emergency rescue
