Concrete pump trucks, weighing 80,000 lbs., are the biggest, most complex, and expensive equipment on a jobsite.

Responsibilities

- Coordinate the placement of concrete throughout the work site
- Operate the vehicle and pump; load and unload concrete pumps and attachments
- Perform pre-operational inspections, safety, and operational checks
- Perform preventative maintenance to equipment, concrete pumps, and components
- Resolve issues related to the movement of concrete
- Read and interprets government legislation, site plans & manufacturers' manuals (i.e., survey indicators)
- Communicate through various techniques, including hand signals
